## AN ACT

To authorize the Clay County bridge district, in the State of Arkansas, to construct a bridge over Current River.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the Clay  
4        County bridge district, in the State of Arkansas, to con-  
5        struct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches  
6        thereto across the Current River, at a point suitable to the  
7        interests of navigation, at or near what is known as Finley's  
8        Ferry, which is near the point where the said river crosses  
9        the line between sections 17 and 20, in township 21 north,  
10       range 3 east, in Clay County, Arkansas, in accordance with

1 the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the  
2 construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved  
3 March 23, 1906.

4 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
5 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
