Mr. DRIVER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce and ordered to be printed.

**A BILL**

To authorize the Clay County bridge district, in the State of Arkansas, to construct a bridge over Current River.

1           *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2           *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3           That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the Clay  
4           County bridge district, in the State of Arkansas, to con-  
5           struct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches  
6           thereto across the Current River, at or near what is known  
7           as Finley's Ferry, which is near the point where the said  
8           river crosses the line between sections 17 and 20, in town-  
9           ship 21 north, range 3 east, in Clay County, Arkansas, in  
10          accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act  
11          to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable  
12          waters," approved March 23, 1906.

13           SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
14          Act is hereby expressly reserved.
