AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to construct a bridge over the Saint Croix River between Vanceboro, Maine, and Saint Croix, New Brunswick.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the State
4 of Maine to construct, maintain, and operate jointly with
5 the Dominion of Canada a bridge to be located over the
6 Saint Croix River at a point suitable to the interests of navi-
7 gation, between Vanceboro, State of Maine, and Saint Croix,
8 Province of New Brunswick, in accordance with the pro-
9 visions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the con-
10 struction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March
11 23, 1906: *Provided*, That the construction of said bridge

1 shall not be commenced until the consent of the Parliament
2 or other proper authority of the Dominion of Canada for the
3 erection of the structure shall have been obtained.

4 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
5 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
