Mr. NELSON of Maine introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing the construction of an international highway bridge over the Saint Croix River between Vanceboro, Maine, and Saint Croix, New Brunswick.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby given to the State of
4 Maine to construct, maintain, and operate jointly with the
5 Dominion of Canada a highway bridge to be located over
6 the Saint Croix River between Vanceboro, State of Maine,
7 and Saint Croix, Province of New Brunswick; the location
8 and the type of structure to be suitable to the interests of
9 river navigation and in accordance with the provisions of
10 the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of
11 bridges over navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906:

1 *Provided*, That the construction of said bridge shall not be
2 commenced until the consent of the Parliament or other
3 proper authority of the Dominion of Canada shall have been
4 obtained: *Provided further*, That the right to alter, amend,
5 or repeal this Act is expressly reserved.
