## A BILL

For the construction of a bridge across the Saint John River between Fort Kent, Maine, and Clairs, Province of New Brunswick, Canada.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the consent of Congress is hereby ~~given to~~ *granted for*  
4        the construction, maintenance, and operation by the State of  
5        Maine and the Dominion of Canada, jointly, of a ~~highway~~  
6        bridge to be erected across the Saint John River, at a point  
7        suitable to the interests of navigation, between Fort Kent,  
8        Maine, and Clairs, Province of New Brunswick, Canada, in  
9        accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An  
10       Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable

1 waters," approved March 23, 1906: *Provided*, That the  
2 construction of said bridge shall not be commenced until  
3 the consent of the proper authorities of the Dominion of  
4 Canada for the erection of the structure shall have been  
5 obtained.

6 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
7 Act is hereby expressly reserved.

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill granting the  
consent of Congress for the construction of a bridge across  
the Saint John River between Fort Kent, Maine, and Clairs,  
Province of New Brunswick, Canada."
