AN ACT

Authorizing the construction of a bridge across the Ohio River to connect the city of Benwood, West Virginia, and the city of Bellaire, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled;*
3 That the Interstate Bridge Company, a corporation organ-
4 ized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, its
5 successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to construct,
6 maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto across
7 the Ohio River, at a point suitable to the interests of naviga-
8 tion, to and into the city of Benwood, Union District, county
9 of Marshall, in the State of West Virginia, from the central
10 part of the city of Bellaire, county of Belmont, in the State
11 of Ohio, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled

1 "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over
2 navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
4 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
