## AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the board of supervisors of Hinds County, Mississippi, to construct a bridge across the Pearl River in the State of Mississippi.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the board  
4 of supervisors of Hinds County, Mississippi, to construct,  
5 maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto  
6 across the Pearl River, at a point suitable to the interests of  
7 navigation, at or near the city of Jackson, State of Missis-  
8 sippi, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled  
9 "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navi-  
10 gable waters," approved March 23, 1906.

- 1        SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
 2 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
