AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the county of Kankakee, State of Illinois, and the counties of Lake and Newton, State of Indiana, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto across the Kankakee River at or near the State line between section 19, township 31 north, range 15 east of the third principal meridian, in the county of Kankakee, State of Illinois, and section 1, township 31 north, range 10 west of the second principal meridian, in the counties of Lake and Newton, State of Indiana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the county
4 of Kankakee, State of Illinois, and the counties of Lake and
5 Newton, State of Indiana, to construct, maintain, and operate
6 a bridge and approaches thereto across the Kankakee River
7 at a point suitable to the interests of navigation, at or

1 near the State line between section 19, township 31
2 north, range 15 east of the third principal meridian, in the
3 county of Kankakee, State of Illinois, and section 1, town-
4 ship 31 north, range 10 west of the second principal me-
5 ridian, in the counties of Lake and Newton, State of Indiana,
6 in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An
7 Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable
8 waters," approved March 23, 1906.

9 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
10 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
