AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the construction of a bridge
across the Rio Grande.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the El
4 Paso Electric Railway Company and the El Paso and Juarez
5 Traction Company, corporations organized and existing
6 under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Texas, and
7 their successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, and
8 operate an electric street railway, vehicular, and foot bridge,
9 and approaches thereto, across the Rio Grande at a point
10 suitable to the interests of navigation at or near the point
11 where South Stanton Street, in said city of El Paso, crosses

1 the Rio Grande, in the county of El Paso, State of Texas
 2 (to replace the wooden bridge now in use at or near the
 3 aforesaid location, operated by said corporations under the
 4 authority of an Act of Congress passed and approved July
 5 28, 1882), in accordance with the provisions of the Act
 6 entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges
 7 over navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906, such
 8 construction to be made only with the consent and approval
 9 of the Republic of Mexico.

10 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
 11 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
