AN ACT

To authorize the allotment of certain lands within the Fort Yuma Indian Reservation, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he hereby is,
4 authorized in his discretion to vacate in whole or in part
5 the withdrawal of lands for town-site purposes known as the
6 town site of Powell on the Fort Yuma Indian Reservation,
7 California, made pursuant to the Act of April 30, 1908
8 (Thirty-fifth Statutes at Large, page 77), and the with-
9 drawal for Indian school farm purposes made pursuant to
10 the Act of August 1, 1914 (Thirty-eighth Statutes at Large,
11 pages 582-587), all areas so vacated being hereby made
12 available for allotment in severalty under existing laws to

1 any Indians entitled to allotment on said reservation who
2 have not heretofore received an allotment.

3 The Secretary of the Interior is hereby further author-
4 ized to set aside and reserve for Indian school farm pur-
5 poses any other lands within said reservation which have
6 not heretofore been otherwise disposed of.
