Mr. SNYDER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs and ordered to be printed.

Committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To authorize the allotment of certain lands within the Fort Yuma Indian Reservation, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he hereby is,
4 authorized in his discretion to vacate in whole or in part
5 the withdrawal of lands for town-site purposes known as the
6 town site of Powell on the Fort Yuma Indian Reservation,
7 California, made pursuant to the Act of April 30, 1908
8 (Thirty-fifth Statutes at Large, page 77), and the withdrawal
9 for Indian school farm purposes made pursuant to the Act of
10 August 1, 1914 (Thirty-eighth Statutes at Large, pages
11 582-587), all areas so vacated being hereby made available

1 for allotment in severalty under existing laws to any Indians
2 entitled to allotment on said reservation who have not hereto-
3 force received an allotment.

4 The Secretary of the Interior is hereby further author-
5 ized to set aside and reserve for Indian school farm pur-
6 poses any other lands within said reservation which have
7 not heretofore been otherwise disposed of.

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
