AN ACT

To authorize the Federal Power Commission to amend permit
numbered 1, project numbered 1, issued to the Dixie Power
Company.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Federal Power Commission be, and it is hereby,
4 authorized and directed, on application made therefor by the
5 Dixie Power Company, to amend preliminary permit num-
6 bered 1, project numbered 1, on the White River in Arkansas
7 issued on March 3, 1921, as amended by order of said com-
8 mission on March 14, 1923, extending the expiration of said
9 amended permit to March 1, 1924, so as to extend said permit
10 as amended by authority of this Act for eighteen months from

1 the approval of this Act, such extension being desired and
2 necessary in order to enable the permittee to prepare maps,
3 plans, and estimates, for incorporation in its application for
4 license and to finance its project and to enable it to further
5 test the river bed by core drilling to determine the most
6 suitable foundation for its dam under said permit, and to
7 enable it to comply with any other requirements of law and
8 regulations of said power commission in making an applica-
9 tion for a license.

10 SEC. 2. ~~That all laws and parts of laws in conflict here-~~
11 ~~with be, and the same are hereby, repealed.~~
