MR. CARAWAY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A BILL

To authorize the Federal Power Commission to amend permit numbered 1, project numbered 1, issued to the Dixie Power Company.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Federal Power Commission be, and it is hereby,
4 authorized and directed, on application made therefor by
5 the Dixie Power Company, to amend preliminary permit
6 numbered 1, project numbered 1, on the White River in
7 Arkansas issued on March 3, 1921, as amended by order
8 of said commission on March 14, 1923, extending the ex-
9 piration of said amended permit to March 1, 1924, so as
10 to extend said permit as amended by authority of this Act

1 for eighteen months from the approval of this Act, such
2 extension being desired and necessary in order to enable
3 the permittee to prepare maps, plans, and estimates, for
4 incorporation in its application for license and to finance its
5 project and to enable it to further test the river bed by core
6 drilling to determine the most suitable foundation for its dam
7 under said permit, and to enable it to comply with any other
8 requirements of law and regulations of said power com-
9 mission in making an application for a license.

10 SEC. 2. That all laws and parts of laws in conflict here-
11 with be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
