Mr. WINN introduced the following bill: which was referred to the Committee on Banking and Currency

A BILL

To amend title I of the Housing Act of 1949 to provide that the special rule for determining the acquisition price of property damaged by subsidence of coal mines shall extend also to property damaged by subsidence of other mines.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That the last paragraph of section 110 (e) of the Housing
4 Act of 1949 is amended by striking out "underlying coal
5 mines" and inserting in lieu thereof "underlying mines".

6 SEC. 2. Any contract under title I of the Housing Act
7 of 1949 executed prior to the date of the enactment of this
8 Act may be amended to provide for payment of the increased
9 amounts authorized under the first section of this Act with

1 respect to any uncompleted project if the project included
 2 acquisitions which, under any State or local law in effect on
 3 such date, would involve expenditures by a local public
 4 agency that could not otherwise be included in the cost of
 5 such project.
