SIR: I ask the Congress to consider proposed supplemental appro-  
priations for the fiscal year 1974 in the amount of \$9,360,000 for the

SIR: I have the honor to submit for your consideration proposed supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year 1974 in the amount of \$9,360,000 for the Executive Office of the President, as follows:

EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT

FEDERAL ENERGY OFFICE

SALARIES AND EXPENSES

For necessary expenses of the Federal Energy Office established by Executive Order Number 11748, dated December 4, 1973, including hire of passenger motor vehicles and services as authorized by title 5, United States Code, section 3109, but at rates for individuals not to exceed the per diem equivalent of the rate for grade GS-18, \$9,360,000.

This proposed supplemental appropriation will provide funds needed for the establishment of the Federal Energy Office, created by Executive Order 11748 of December 4, 1973. This Office will provide the basis for improved management and coordination of Federal energy resource activities.

I have carefully reviewed the proposals for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that these requests are necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that these proposals be transmitted to the Congress.
