SIR: I have the honor to submit for your consideration a proposed supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year 1974 in the amount of \$150,000 for the Pennsylvania Avenue Development Corporation, as follows:

PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

SALARIES AND EXPENSES

For an additional amount, as authorized by Section 17 of Public Law 92-578, \$150,000, to remain available until expended.

The proposed supplemental appropriation would provide funds for more detailed analysis and cost estimates during the course of formulating a development plan for the Pennsylvania Avenue area.

I have carefully reviewed this proposed supplemental request and am satisfied that it is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that it be transmitted to the Congress.
