CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That (a) the statue of Jack Swigert, fur-
3 nished by the State of Colorado for placement in National
4 Statuary Hall in accordance with section 1814 of the Re-
5 vised Statutes of the United States (40 U.S.C. 187), is

1 accepted in the name of the United States, and the thanks
2 of the Congress are tendered to the State of Colorado for
3 providing this commemoration of one of its most eminent
4 personages.

5 (b) The State of Colorado is authorized to use the
6 rotunda of the Capitol on May 22, 1997, at 11 o'clock,
7 ante meridiem, for a presentation ceremony for the statue.
8 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board
9 shall take such action as may be necessary with respect
10 to physical preparations and security for the ceremony.

11 (c) The statue shall be displayed in the rotunda of
12 the Capitol for a period of not more than six months, after
13 which period the statue shall be moved to its permanent
14 location in National Statuary Hall.

15 SEC. 2. The Clerk of the House of Representatives
16 shall transmit a copy of this concurrent resolution to the
17 Governor of Colorado.
